2008 RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS

OBJECT: Car, Body, Engine, Suspension

1. Car must be a 1960 or newer year/model
2. No pickups, 4x4, or jeeps
3. Engines can be 4, 6, or 8 cylinders and must be factory stock, compatible to year/model. Also transmission must be factory stock to year/model.
4. No locked rear ends
5. Air cleaner to oil pan must be factory stock
6. Engine must be strictly factory stock for car type. Note: engine mounts also factory stock. No after market external oil coolers
7. Wheel base allowed, as follows: V-8 105" and 4 cylinder and 6 cylinder 88"
8. Roll cage is mandatory. Doors must have 4 bars for each side. Plating of door bars recommended
9. Bumpers must be factory stock related to year/model
10. All burnable type material must be removed
11. Floor plan, firewall, trunk, wheel wells and fuel take must be retained as factory stock equipment. Fuel cells ok and recommended.
12. All cars must retain factory stock appearance. Note: no cutting, chopping, channeling or shortening allowed
13. Car factory stock hook and latch must be retained
14. Car suspension parts must absolutely remain as factory stock to match make/model
15. Car must retain factory stock wheel
16. Mesh window nets are mandatory on both Driver side window and passenger side window.
17. Both driver and passenger MUST wear a 5 point racing harness. Shoulder harness must be fastened to roll cage.
18. Clothing: Long sleeve and pants, closed shoes, helmet, eye protection and gloves. Single layer fire suit recommended.

GENERAL

1. Driver will operate steering control only
2. Passenger will operate gas pedal
3. Gas pedal/cable may be changed, i.e.: shortened, extended, etc for passenger side operation
4. No rear view mirrors permitted
5. All glass will be removed from car. Vertical Steel Bars must be added to the full length of windshield opening 4" apart.
6. \$500 claim for the complete car is allowed

NOTE: driver/owner for car allowed to keep safety equipment, i.e. racing seats, belts, and fuel cells. However, another driver, any person in pits or stands or the Track Promoter can claim car. If multiple claims on the same car occur, a random drawing will decide the winner

- In the event driver/owner does not honor the claim, he is subjected to being suspended indefinitely.
- Econo Tire Rule applies
